# Rules and Regulations For Broken Arrow Middle School Orchestra

# I. GENERAL CONDUCT

A. Attendance is required at all extra rehearsals in public performances. The only excuses are listed in area IV.

1. The director must be notified in advance if the student will be absent or tardy at an extra rehearsal or performance. The notification may be made by phone or in writing by parent or guardian.

B. Students are to ride school transportation to and from school activities outside Broken Arrow

C. School owned instruments are checked out in good shape. Students must check them back in the same condition. If the instrument is damaged, the student will be responsible for paying the cost of the damage. Rental for school owned instruments is \$35 per semester/summer.

D. Reasons for dismissal from orchestra, dismissal from the elective class with no credit, and/or suspension from the performances are set by the School Board of Broken Arrow and Broken Arrow Middle Schools as described in the student/faculty handbook. Any penalties in addition to the school penalties are at the discretion of the orchestra director and could be imposed for the following violations:

1. Using profanity at directors or fellow students.

2. Intentionally damaging or destroying any orchestra property such as music stands, school owned or personal instruments, uniforms, or facilities.

3. Violating any school rule listed in the student handbook.

4. Fund-raising activities are offered to help students raise the needed funds for trips. The student must keep this account current to be able to travel/participate in the scheduled activity. A payment schedule will be set and the students are required to turn in the set amount at that time, whether it is from fundraising or personal accounts.

## II. UNIFORMS:

The uniform for orchestra will be:

**Guys:** Black or dark dress slacks, dark socks, dark shoes (No canvas or tennis shoes), white dress shirt and tie (sixth grade tie is optional).

Girls:

Black or dark skirt or slacks, hose, dress shoes, white blouse. Skirt should be below the knee. Girls playing cello or a bass are encouraged to wear black dress slacks or long, full skirts.

## **III. ORCHESTRA ROOM:**

- A. Proper respect for orchestra property will be adhered to at all times.
- B. No candy or gum chewing in the orchestra room.
- C. No drinks or food will be allowed in the orchestra room, unless the director establishes a designated area.
- D. No trash of any kind is to be left in the orchestra room. Please work together with your section to keep the area clean.
- E. No instruments are to be left on the floor after rehearsals.
- F. Cello and bass players will put the covers back on their instruments after each rehearsal, and put in their endpins. If

there is a rack, your instrument needs to be on the rack each day.

G. Students are responsible to keep track of their own music once it is given out.

# IV. ABSENCES FROM REQUIRED REHEARSALS OR PERFORMANCES

# ALL SCHEDULED REHEARSALS AND PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY



The following guidelines will be used for authorized absences:

- A. Illnesses (Director should be notified prior to the required rehearsal or performance).
- B. Family Emergency (Directors should be notified prior to required rehearsal or performance).
- C. Any conflicts of school activities which have been previously resolved with directors and principal.
- D. Any other reason for an absence will be considered unauthorized.

E. Students will have the grade lowered one letter grade for each unauthorized absence from any performance or any specifically designated rehearsal as in the school board policy 4370. "Student Responsibility to Performing Arts and Activity Groups".

## V. GRADING POLICY:

Participation 45%

- 1. Get to class in your chair promptly and stay there.
- 2. Play every line, participate in each exercise, or turn in completed written work.
- 3. Have your instrument and materials every day.
- Tests (played and/or written) 45%

Semester test (played and/or written) 10%

\* Concert Attendance

Missing concerts may result in the loss of a letter grade (see student handbook).

## VI. TARDIES:

Students will be in their seats with her music, a pencil for marking music and their instrument ready to be tuned five minutes after the bell.

## VII. COMPETITIVE PERFORMANCES:

All students must be eligible to compete according to guidelines set by Broken Arrow Public Schools and the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Activities Association.

# **VIII. CODE OF CONDUCT**

That responsibility and opportunity carries with it an obligation to protect and maintain the absolute highest moral and musical integrity.
